STRENGTHENING FAMILIES IN FORSYTH COUNTY



- **Parents as Teachers (PAT),** Imprints Cares' cornerstone program, walks alongside families through intensive home visits where parents embrace their role as their child's first best teacher. Family Educators visit homes twice a month, providing valuable support to help parents prepare their child to be **Ready for School**.
- **Pediatric Parenting Connections (PPC)** is a pediatric model that embeds highly qualified family educators into pediatric practices to provide evidence-based education and developmental assessments for parents of young children. PPC addresses social drivers of health and connects families to appropriate community resources to ensure children are **Ready for School**.
- **Family Friend and Neighbors (FFN)** offers Provider Educators that support informal home care providers through professional development and resources to enhance child development and promote a healthy learning environment. FFN provides valuable support to help parents prepare and caregivers prepare children to be **Ready for School**.
- **Book Babies** partners with families to discover the joy of reading. Starting at or before 4 months old, home visitors provide quarterly visits, age-appropriate books to the whole family, and literacy coaching to promote a literacy-rich home environment and ensure children are **Ready for School**.
- **Kindergarten Connections** provides practical support for families navigating the complex educational landscape with limited resources. This **Expanded Learning** provided underserved and barrier-challenged families with school-aged children who, without intervention, face significant risk of being overlooked by traditional educational systems.
- **Expanded Learning** programs serves school aged students through high-quality before and after school care, summer enrichment camps, and an inclusion program for typically developing students as well as students with exceptional needs. The **Expanded Learning** program promotes everyday learning and ensures workforce support for families who need it most.

Students in our programs demonstrate improved academic outcomes, reducing long-term educational costs, while our organization contributes roughly \$3.2 million in wages to the local economy.






Students who participated in Imprints Cares' Parents as Teachers program statistically performed one year higher than their peer comparison.




